Year 11 Mock Examinations

I am writing to you about the two-week and two day mock examination period that will begin for Year 11 pupils on Monday, 30 October and last until Tuesday, 14 November inclusive. The mock examinations will mostly take place in the main Sports Hall and small Sports Hall.

I will outline to Year 11 the protocols for examinations in the Sports Hall but it is worth parents and pupils bearing in mind the following:

- Pupils should line up on the tennis courts 10 minutes before the scheduled examination
- Pupils should bring their own pens, pencils, rulers and mathematical equipment in a transparent plastic case
- No equipment will be handed out to pupils who do not bring their own equipment
- Pupils should not share any of their equipment with other pupils prior or during the examinations
- Pupils should ensure that mobile phones are not taken into the Examination Hall
- Pupils can bring bottles of water but all labels must have been taken off before entering the Examination hall
- No food will be allowed in the Examination Hall

Please find attached a copy of the Mock Examination timetable which will also be in tutor bases for pupils to consult.

For information, the results of the mocks will be issued on Friday, 8 December at 8.35am in the TCC.
