Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing to inform you of matters relating to Year 11 in the upcoming weeks as we begin the 'run up' to the summer exams. The first is that there will be a programme of revision workshops in the February half term holiday that your child may wish to benefit from. Attendance is not mandatory but you will understand that these sessions can only be beneficial to your child. Pupils will not have to wear uniform when attending and may bring snacks and drinks to help them work effectively. The two hour sessions will run from 10.00am to 12.00 noon (morning) and 1.00pm to 3.00pm (afternoon). Please note that as these workshops are being offered outside of our normal term-time timetable, with only a small number of students and staff on site, there will not be our usual first aid arrangements in place. Should an incident arise, staff will contact home initially and 999 in an emergency.
