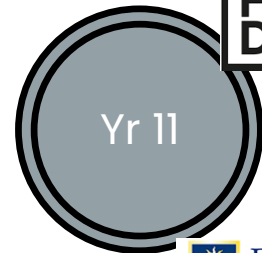

We work in partnership with Portsmouth City Council with careers events and to mentor students who need support to enter post-16 education or training.



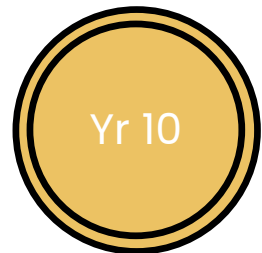

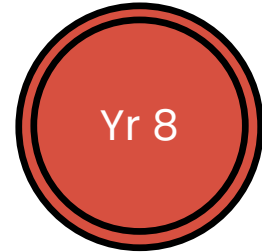
